AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE

At a regular meeting of the Township of Sandstone held on the 14 day of Dec., 1987, at 7:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time in the Township Hall, the following Amendment to Ordinance No. 4 was offered by Member P. Sutliff and supported by Member Don Clark.

BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Township Board of the Township of Sandstone, County of Jackson, State of Michigan, that Ordinance No. 4 be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. EXEMPTION FROM ACT 230 OF 1972

It is further ordained that the Township of Sandstone elects to exempt itself from Public Act 230 of 1972 and hereby adopts by reference the Building Officials and Code Administration basic building code, commonly known as BOCA, the 1987 Edition.

The foregoing Amendment shall be published once, in full, in the ^{Payma News} ~~Jackson Citizen~~ (CH) Patriot, a newspaper of general circulation within the boundaries of the Township of Sandstone and qualified under State Law to publish legal notices, promptly after its adoption and the same shall be recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Township.
