TOWNSHIP OF SANDSTONE
AMENDMENT TO DISMANTLED CAR ORDINANCE

At a Regular meeting of the Sandstone Township Board held on the 14th day of August, 1978, at 7:30 p.m., in the Sandstone Township Hall, the following amendment was heard and passed:

AMENDMENT TO SECTION III - REGULATIONS

Section III - Regulations, will be amended by the addition of the following subparagraphs:

(d) No person, firm or corporation shall park or store any dismantled or inoperable motor vehicle or parts thereof on any premises in the Township of Sandstone, unless such premises shall be duly licensed under the provisions of the Sandstone Township Dismantled Car Ordinance, for a period of more than seven (7) days continuously, and no person, firm or corporation shall permit any dismantled, partially dismantled or inoperable motor vehicles or parts thereof to remain on any premises in the Township of Sandstone, unless such premises are duly licensed under the provisions of the Sandstone Township Dismantled Car Ordinance, for a period of more than thirty (30) days consecutively. This section shall not apply to dismantled, partially dismantled or inoperable motor vehicles or parts thereof stored in a closed building.

(e) Motor vehicles are hereby defined as any wheeled vehicle which are self-propelled or intended to be self-propelled. Inoperable motor vehicles are defined as motor vehicles which, by reason of dismantling, disrepair or other cause, are incapable of being propelled under their own power. Dismantled and partially dismantled motor vehicles are defined as motor vehicles from which some part or parts which are ordinarily a component of such motor vehicle has been removed or is missing. Any motor vehicle which does not bear a currently effective license issued by the

State of Michigan shall be considered an inoperable motor vehicle and excepting those vehicles which are used seasonal for the purpose of operating a farm or other business and for which a semi-annual license may be purchased. These vehicles must be in operable condition at all times.

This Amendment shall be published in the manner provided by law and shall take effect immediately upon publication.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
