

TOWNSHIP OF SANDSTONE

AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE INDEMNITY
AGREEMENTS FROM TOWNSHIP CONTRACTORS

ORDINANCE NO. 32

At a regular meeting of the Township of Sandstone Board held on the 13 day of June, 1994 at 7:00 p.m., the following Ordinance was heard and passed:

THE TOWNSHIP OF SANDSTONE ORDAINS:

SECTION 1.

That any person, firm, corporation, partnership, or other entity that enters into a contract with the Township to provide services, products, or perform work for the Township shall execute an indemnity agreement to the Township.

SECTION 2.

The indemnity agreement shall indemnify and hold harmless the Township for any loss or damage to property, for any injury to person, for any business interruption, loss of income, expenses, or any costs of litigation resulting from any act or omission of the indemnitor. The agreement shall be in a form and containing language agreeable to the Township.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be severable and should any part, provision or paragraph hereof be declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the remaining provisions hereof.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
