<b>Governor</b> Vote for not more than 1	<b>Governor</b> Vote for not more than 1	Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation, imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution, in the Charter of Township of Sandstone of 0.5 mill (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 0.4994 mills (\$0.4994 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, which is set to expire on December 31, 2022, be renewed at and increased up to the original voted 0.50 mill (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for five (5) years, 2023 through 2027 inclusive, to be used to provide police protection and public safety services for the residents of Sandstone Charter Township, whether by contracting for such services or establishing a police department. This millage will raise an estimated Seventy Six Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$76,400) in the first year the millage is levied.
