Dear Board Members:

The following is a highlight of some of the more significant events handled by Jackson County deputies for the month of May 2025:

On May 2nd, and several times since, Deputies responded to the 4200 block of N. Dearing Rd. for a property line dispute. The dispute between neighbors has centered around the upkeep, mowing and landscaping of the adjoining property lines, and several inches of grass between. Deputies also responded to stand-by while each party placed trespassing notice signs on their respective property.

On May 4th, Deputies responded to a residence in the 7100 block of Springport Rd. for a suicidal subject in possession of multiple weapons. Responding deputies were able to de-escalate the situation and take the subject into protective custody without incident. The subject was transported to Henry Ford Health Jackson for evaluation.

On May 7th, Deputies responded to the 1300 block of Sandstone Creek Dr. for a domestic disturbance. Family members at the residence were in dispute over personal property with threats to escalate to a physical confrontation. Responding deputies were able to separate the individuals and mediate the exchange of property without further incident.

On May 9th, Deputies responded to the 7200 block of W. Michigan Ave. for an assault in progress. The resident on W. Michigan Ave. was threatened with a weapon by an individual that was inquiring about a vehicle the resident had displayed for sale. The suspect was located a short distance from the residence, and taken into custody. The Jackson County Prosecuting Attorney's Office authorized charges for felonious assault and resisting and opposing officers, with a 4th habitual offender notice.

On May 17th, Deputies responded to a residence in the 4100 block of Gardner Rd. for a reported tractor accident. Deputies located a subject in the river on the property and rendered emergency aid, however the subject did not survive. Through the initial investigation, it appears the subject suffered a medical emergency and subsequently drowned. The tractor, located nearby, did not appear to be related to the accidental drowning.

The detachment investigated 44 calls for service, investigated 4 traffic crashes, conducted 16 traffic stops, issued 4 citations, and made 3 arrests for the month.
